It is extremely unlikely that section 303 (d) of the Clean Water Act provides the EPA with the authority to require each implementation plans. Although this may seem like a minor legal issue, in fact, it could potentially hold grave consequences for private landowners across the country. If, for example, the EPA were to reject an implementation plan based on inadequate riparian buffer widths, even if the buffers were State-approved best management practices, EPA would be free to rewrite the implementation plan under the loop-hole that the Agency has provided itself with the authority to do so by this proposed rule.
